RE: Approve Request by Florida Power & Light (FPL) for Road Closure of Mediterranean Road

DATE: June 2, 2022

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Town staff recommends that Town Council approve the request for Florida Power & Light (FPL) to close Mediterranean Road for three (3) days and a lane closure for two (2) days to complete work at 1500 North Ocean Boulevard.

GENERAL INFORMATION

FPL is requesting a waiver to be able to complete work that will require a road and lane closure on Mediterranean Road to install an underground cable and transformer at 1500 North Ocean Boulevard. The work is required to provide electric service to a new home.

If the waiver is approved, all property owners impacted by the road closure will be notified prior to the start of the job. Access to the homes will be maintained and coordinated by FPL. Each night the road will be opened for use. FPL is requesting the job to take place from Monday to Friday from 8:00am to 6:00pm. A three (3) day road closure and a two (2) day lane closure is required. This includes the transformer and cable installation and road restoration.

Public Works recommends approval of the waiver request. If approved, Public Works will work directly with FPL to coordinate the necessary right-of-way permit and the appropriate day to complete this work.

FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT

There are no funding implications.
