## **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends the Town Council accept a donation from the Palm Beach Police & Fire Foundation in the amount of \$50,000 for Townwide surveillance camera program purchases made as deemed appropriate and necessary by the Chief of Police and the Town Manager in accordance with the Town's Purchasing Procedures.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Palm Beach Police Department continues to benefit from the generosity of the residents and businesses of the Town of Palm Beach. The Department has recently received intentions of a donation of \$50,000 from the Palm Beach Police & Fire Foundation. The donor has indicated that the funds should be utilized as deemed appropriate and necessary by the Chief of Police and the Town Manager for Townwide surveillance camera projects for the Police Department.

Per Town Administration Policy No. 1-08-08 (Attachment A), any donation with a value over \$25,000, which is not included in the Town's budget, must be approved by Town Council.

## **FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT**

The donation will be forwarded to the Finance Department for deposit in the Police Department's donation account. Purchases made using donated funds will be made in accordance with established Procurement Procedures.
