STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The information contained herein is provided to Town Council for review and approval.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Collective Bargaining Agreement (Non-Supervisory Unit) between the Town of Palm Beach and the Professional Firefighters/Paramedics, Palm Beach County, Local 2928 expired on September 30, 2022. Following mutual consultation, agreement was reached between the two parties to sign a new identical contract for a 12-month period without changes, except for the dates of the agreement. Rationale for this is that collective bargaining contracts cannot exceed a three-year period. However, a new identical contract may be drawn for a twelve-month period. The contract will be examined in more detail during a more fulsome collective bargaining process in the coming year during which modifications may be proposed and brought forth.

The one-year contract has been voted on and ratified by the Collective Bargaining Unit at their meetings of September 21, 22 and 23, 2022 and the one-year contract and resolution are attached for signatures.

The Town Attorney was consulted throughout the process. Additional counsel was sought from the Town's labor attorney. Advice from both have been incorporated into the recommendations herein.
