STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Town staff requests that Town Council review the attached information and provide direction concerning any additional study items, a possible public workshop, and referring study items to the Tax and Finance Committee.

GENERAL INFORMATION

During the November 8, 2022 Town Council Meeting, Kimley Horn and Associates presented additional information on alternatives to include: City of West Palm Beach – As Is, City of West Palm Beach – Membrane Upgrade, City of Lake Worth Beach – Membrane Upgrade, new infrastructure and pipping on the island, new infrastructure and pipping in the intracoastal waterway.

Following the presentation at the November 8, 2022 Town Council Meeting, Council requested for staff and Kimley Horn and Associates to provide additional information on alternatives regarding the following subjects:

1. City of West Palm Beach – As Is w/cost analysis
2. City of West Palm Beach – Membrane Upgrade w/cost analysis
3. City of Lake Worth Beach – Membrane Upgrade w/cost analysis
 - i. New infrastructure and pipe upgrades on the island
 - ii. Comparison of upgrades to current age of pipes
4. Phipps Ocean Park Treatment Plant – Location on west side of South Ocean Boulevard

Kimley Horn and Associates will be presenting an update on the Water Feasibility Study at the December 13, 2022 Town Council Meeting.
