GENERAL INFORMATION

On December 6, 2022, the Town of Palm Beach held its 111th Town Caucus for the purpose of nominating candidates for the Offices of Town of Palm Beach Mayor and Town Council Member Groups 1 and 2. There being only one nomination for Mayor, candidate Danielle H. Moore was declared unopposed and to be elected to the Office of Town of Palm Beach Mayor, effective as of the date of the general election, March 14, 2023. There being only one nomination for Council Member Group 1, candidate Julie Araskog was declared unopposed and to be elected to the Office of Town Council Member Group 1, effective as of the date of the general election, March14, 2023. There being only one nomination for Council Member Group 2, candidate Edward A. "Ted" Cooney was declared unopposed and to be elected to the Office of Town Council Member Group 2, effective as of the date of the general election, March 14, 2023. Their nominations being shown by the certified copy of the Minutes of said Caucus, which said certified copy is made a part of the Resolution.
