

**MAYOR’S PROCLAMATION TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS
OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH, FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Charter of the Town of Palm Beach, Florida, and the General Laws pertaining thereto, no election will be held in the Town of Palm Beach, Florida, on the 14th day of March 2023, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and two Town Council persons, for two year periods; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Palm Beach, Florida, on December 9, 2022, at a special adjourned session assembled, duly adopted a resolution calling for no election on said date, and directing the Mayor of the Town to issue her proclamation thereof, and

WHEREAS, it is hereby declared that the following candidates have been nominated and qualified for election to the seats without opposition for Mayor – Danielle H. Moore, Town Council Person in Group 1- Julie Araskog and Group 2 – Edward A. “Ted” Cooney.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Danielle H. Moore, Mayor of the Town of Palm Beach, Florida, hereby give notice and make proclamation that there will not be an election, on the 14th day of March 2023, for electing a Mayor and two Town Council Persons, for two-year periods.
