STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The Town staff recommends approving the Award of a Change Order to Bridges, Marsh & Associates for Renovations to the North Fire Station in the Amount of \$170,000 for a Total Awarded Purchase Order of \$566,000.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Bridges, Marsh & Associates were awarded the RFQ for the North Fire Restoration Project – Architectural, Engineering Design Construction Services at the November 2, 2021, Town Council Meeting.

Pursuant to their agreement, Bridges, Marsh & Associates have requested a Change Order in the Amount of \$170,000 to address the following impact to the original Scope of the Project:

- The original duration of the renovation work/services by the Project Architect and Consultants will be required to be extended.
- Current state of the existing building/systems resulting from existing structural and building system deficiencies.
- More-in-depth investigation into non-conforming elements of the building.
- Failing structural systems: Design of new foundation improvement (Helical Piling)
- Removal and replacement of all roof structures including truss roof systems.
- Unexpected deterioration of building components
- Additional Pre-construction services
- Alternative design approach
- Extended Construction Administrative Services

The issues noted above are articulated in detail at the weekly progress meetings which include Bridges, Marsh & Associates. Hedrick Brothers Construction, Public Works, Fire, Information Technology and Procurement & Contract Management.

This project will be funded from the Capital Improvement Fund.
