Project Location and Scope of Services



PROJECT LOCATION

- Project is in the Town of Palm Beach in Palm Beach County
- Project limits are from North of Emerald Beach Way to South of S.R. 704/Royal Palm Way









PROJECT SCOPE OF SERVICES

- Repaving the existing roadway
- Upgrading Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) issues
- Improving drainage to avoid ponding
- Sidewalk improvements and shared lane pavement markings
- Preserving and protecting existing vegetation
- Upgrading lighting
- Replacing signal heads and emergency signals






EXISTING CONDITIONS

Existing Typical Section 1 from North of Emerald Beach Way to Hammon Avenue:

- Two-lane, two-way urban collector with 11-foot travel lanes
- Shoulder varying from 2 feet to 5.5 feet
- A minimum 4.5-foot concrete sidewalk runs along the northbound lane starting north of Ocean Boulevard






EXISITNG CONDITIONS

Existing Typical Section 2 from Hammon Avenue to Chilean Avenue:

- Four-lane undivided section with 10.5foot travel lanes
- 8-foot parallel parking along the northbound lanes
- Type D Curb on the outside with varying width sidewalk on both sides






EXISTING CONDITIONS

Existing Typical Section 3 from Chilean Avenue to Brazilian Avenue:

- Two-way pair, each pair consisting of a two-lane section with 11 to 12-foot travel lanes
- 8-foot on-street parking
- Type F Curb with varying width sidewalk on both sides






EXISTING CONDITIONS

Existing Typical Section 4 from Brazilian Avenue to South of Royal Palm Way:

- Three-lane undivided section with two 12-foot travel lanes
- 8-foot on-street parking
- Type F Curb and
 9.5-foot sidewalk
 on both sides





Proposed Typical Section 1 from North of Emerald Beach Way to Hammon Avenue:


- Two-lane, two-way urban collector with 12-foot travel lanes
- Shoulder varying from 1 to 4.5 feet in both directions
- 4.5 to 5.5-foot concrete sidewalk along the northbound lane starting north of Ocean Boulevard





Proposed Typical Section 2 from Hammon Avenue to Chilean Avenue:


- Four-lane undivided section with 10-foot travel lanes
- 8-foot on-street parking with buffer along northbound lanes
- Type D Curb on the outside, and 4 to 11-foot sidewalk on both sides of the roadway





Proposed Typical Section 3 from Chilean Avenue to Brazilian Avenue:


- Two-way pair, each pair consisting of a 2-lane section with 10 to 11-foot travel lanes
- 8-foot on-street parking with a buffer
- Type F Curb and varying width sidewalk on both sides





Proposed Typical Section 4 from Brazilian Avenue to South of SR 704/Royal Palm Way:

- Three-lane undivided section with two 10-foot travel lanes
- 8-foot on-street parking with buffer
- Type F Curb and
 9.5-foot sidewalk
 on both sides





MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC



MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC

- During construction, single lane closures will be used to construct the proposed improvements
- Vehicle detours or full road/ intersection closures for drainage and signal improvements
- Temporary impacts to pedestrian traffic will be addressed by temporary pedestrian detours/diversions, as needed

PROJECT SCHEDULE AND COST



- Estimated construction start date: April 2024
- Anticipated completion date: December 2025



Estimated construction cost: \$3.5 Million


