Background

- Phases 6 and 7 of the Utility Undergrounding project will begin construction along North County Road between Wells and Miraflores during 2023/2024.
- Public Works identified this as an opportunity to address drainage and roadway safety issues simultaneously with utility undergrounding.
- All design decisions must place tree canopy health and aesthetic character of the corridor as primary priorities.




- Median curbing was too wide
- Prefer no valley gutter
- Maintain the length/width of median
- Reduce pavement where possible
- Improve drainage along walking path

Background – Safety Concerns

 Westbound traffic turning left (south) out of Canterbury Lane has an unsafe condition due to limited visibility.








Options for Safety Improvements

- Shifting the northbound traffic lane south of Canterbury to the west by 8 feet.
- Eliminates approximately 100-feet of median; Eliminates refuge between medians.
- Improvement of 53-feet in sight distance from existing condition.








Safety Improvement Options

- Shifting the northbound traffic lane south of Canterbury to the west by 8 feet.
- No change in median length; Maintains refuge between medians.


• Improvement of 34-feet in sight distance from existing condition.



Safety Improvement Options

- Shifting the northbound traffic lane south of Canterbury to the west by 8 feet.
- No change in median length; Maintains refuge between medians.

• Improvement of 34-feet in sight distance from existing condition.



- Adding a mountable curb and gutter along the edge of the median
- Provides a clean edge for asphalt pavement
 - Reduces the vehicular traffic driving on the median
 - Raises the median to improve soil drainage
- Underlaying the median turf with a geotextile that gives structural support (similar to the Four Arts Parking Lot)
- Adding a mountable curb and gutter along the outside edge of pavement.





