**Ordinance No. 015-2023**

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of the first reading of Ordinance 015-2023 amending Business Tax Fees and the Business Tax Program. It should be noted that approval of an increase in business taxes will require a majority plus one vote of the Town Council to become effective.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

In **FY23**, the Town to date has issued **1,684** business tax receipts (formerly known as occupational licenses) to local businesses.

Per State Statute (F.S. Chapter 205), the Town may increase business tax fees every two years by an amount not to exceed 5%. The Town's business tax fees were last modified on May 12, 2021, and set the business taxes for the next two fiscal years, commencing on October 1, 2021. Fees were also increased in 2019, 2017, 2015, 2013 and 2011. In 2009, the Town Council elected not to increase fees.

Staff is recommending an increase in fees for FY24 by the allowed 5%. Attached is Ordinance No. 015-2023, which includes the proposed business taxes per occupation and use.

If the Town Council approves first reading of Ordinance No. 015-2023, the ordinance will be placed on the July 11, 2023, Town Council agenda for second and final reading. If adopted, the revised fees will be incorporated into the renewal notices scheduled for issuance on or about July 12, 2023, for the new tax year commencing October 1,2023.

## FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT<sup>1</sup>

Business taxes collected as of **May 8, 2023, are \$918,920,** compared to budgeted revenue for this account of **\$860,000.** Total revenue collected last year was **\$832,756.** The proposed fees will represent an increase in Business Tax Receipts of approximately **\$41,690** annually, commencing in Fiscal Year 2024. This increase is reflected in the Town's Long Term Financial Plan.
