STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Town staff recommends that Town Council approve the Authorization of the South Ocean Boulevard closure for a crane to set up and install Palm Trees at 256 South Ocean Blvd.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The owners of 256 S. Ocean Blvd. desire to install 20-foot Palm Trees on their lot. The required right-ofway permits for the proposed work have been applied for. To complete the work, the contractor has requested a road closure of South Ocean Boulevard for the crane to be set up. The Palm Trees can be delivered on standard 28-foot-long flatbed trucks, which can navigate our roadways. The proposed work would take place the week of September 18th (weather permitting). The contractor is requesting a 4-hour window to perform the work, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Work will be coordinated with other activities occurring this week to minimize traffic impacts.

The roadway detour for northbound traffic is Royal Palm Way, north on South County Road and east up the 100 Block of Seaspray Avenue. An advance Variable Message Board (VMS) on Royal Palm Way (for eastbound traffic) in advance South County Road (with FDOT approval) is planned. For southbound traffic the roadway detour is west on Seaview Avenue to South County Road to Royal Palm Way. Detour map attached.
