RESOLUTION NO. 20-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING BRADLEY PARK AS THE LOCATION FOR THE ERECTION AND DISPLAY OF UNATTENDED SYMBOLS RELATING TO RELIGIOUS HOLIDAYS; DESIGNATING THE TIME FOR DISPLAY OF SAID SYMBOLS; PROVIDING PERMIT PROCEDURES: DECLARING THAT THE TOWN SHOULD HAVE NO INVOLVEMENT IN THE ERECTION OR MAINTENANCE OF SAID DISPLAYS: PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN OTHER CONTENT NEUTRAL REGULATIONS: PROVIDING FOR DISCLAIMER BY THE TOWN; PROVIDING FOR AN PROCESS IN THE EVENT OF APPEAL DENIAL; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Palm

Beach to establish a forum for the erection and display of unattended symbols relating

to religious holidays during that period of the year beginning the day after Thanksgiving

and ending on January 10 of the ensuing year; and

WHEREAS, Bradley Park has been established as a traditional public forum in

the Town; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Bradley Park shall be designated as the

location for the erection and display of unattended symbols relating to religious holidays.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Palm Beach, Florida, as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Bradley Park is hereby designated as the location for the erection and display, pursuant to a permit properly issued by the Town, of unattended symbols relating to religious holidays during that period of the year beginning the day after Thanksgiving and ending on January 10 of the ensuing year. Section 2. A permit procedure shall be established requiring, at a minimum, the following:

A. Application shall be filed with the Town Clerk no less than sixty (60) days and no more than 120 days prior to the date upon which the display is to be erected.

- B. If a special event is planned at any time during the period of the display, a special event permit is also required.
- C. The application shall include a description of the display, the individual or group sponsoring the display, the individual responsible for the display and for accepting all conditions relating thereto.
- D. The application shall be accompanied by a \$150.00 application fee to defray the cost of processing the application.
- E. A description of the power source, if any, required for the display.

Section 3. The Town shall have no involvement, other than through the permitting process, in the erection or maintenance of the display. The applicant shall bear all costs associated with installation, maintenance and removal; including the cost of providing electric, and with restoring the ground, if needed, upon which the display was placed to the condition it was in prior to placement.

Section 4. The height of the display shall not exceed eight (8) feet. The location within Bradley Park shall be at the discretion of the Town, through the Director of Public Works, and shall be stabilized in a manner satisfactory to the Director of Public Works to ensure placement of the display does not present a public safety hazard. Displays shall not include balloons, flags, banners or any other materials determined by the Director of the Department of Public Works to create a potential safety hazard. No

symbols shall remain in place for a period of time in excess of fifteen (15) consecutive days. The placement of said symbols shall not interfere with the use of the park for other park purposes.

<u>Section 5.</u> The Town shall install a sign to be displayed with the permitted display which shall read as follows:

"This display is provided by a private individual or entity at no public expense and does not constitute an endorsement by the Town of Palm Beach of any religion or religious doctrine or of any other message conveyed thereby."

<u>Section 6.</u> Any display not removed upon the date indicated for removal on the permit may be removed by the Town and the cost for removal billed to the individual and/or organization designated as the responsible party for the display.

<u>Section 7.</u> Applications for permits shall be filed with the Town Clerk and shall be acted on by the Town Manager, or his or her designee, within thirty (30) days of the date of the application. In the event an application for permit is not approved within said time period, is denied, or is approved with conditions not acceptable to the applicant, applicant may appeal to the Town Council by filing with the Town Clerk within ten days of said decision or indecision a notice of appeal stating therein the reasons for the appeal. Said appeal shall be heard by the Town Council at its next regular meeting following the filing of the notice of appeal. The Town Council will not, as part of the appeal process, consider waiving any of the permit requirements referenced herein.

Section 8. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
