STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Town Staff recommends approval of Resolution No. 072-2024 awarding BMA for the Mid-Town Nourishment Project & 2022 Palm Beach Harbor Disposal Project to Coastal ECO-Group (CEG), Inc in the amount of \$136,199 and establishing a project budget in the amount \$159,199.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION/BACKGROUND

This scope of work is to complete 2024 monitoring required by the Beach Management Agreement for the Mid-Town Beach Nourishment Project and Palm Beach Harbor Operations and Maintenance Project in Reach 2. The specific scope of work to be implemented is based on FDEP's revised Cell-Wide Monitoring and Mitigation Plans. This includes the 2024 regulatory monitoring for the 2020 Mid-Town Beach Nourishment Project and data analyses/report preparation of the 2024 annual report. The 2024 report will include evaluation of potential project-related effects of the 2020 Mid-Town Beach Nourishment Project relative to variability documented at the BMA transects in the evaluation of project-related effects. The 2024 survey is the Year 1 post-construction survey of the two regulatory transects for the Palm Beach Harbor Operations and Maintenance Project in Reach 2.

CEG was awarded for the same service in 2023 and performed with a high level of satisfaction.

FUNDING IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE

The funding for this project is from the Coastal Program Fund.
