We are pleased to submit the first submittal of the accompanying drawings for our project at 345 Pendleton Lane in Palm Beach. We are requesting the following:

We are proposing to make alterations at the rear of the property including restoring an open terrace and adding a hip roof above. A new pool will replace the existing and the pool deck will be removed. Pool equipment will be relocated, and a generator will be added. Other changes include replacing non-original casement and awning windows with single-hung wood windows and installing a new impact-rated garage door, all to match the existing. The landscaping will be upgraded and garden walls added. No variances are required.

Section 54-122:

- New non-impact windows will match the existing wood mahogany single hung windows.
- The new hip roof will match the slope of the existing hip roofs. The white concrete roof tile will match the existing roof. All detailing will match the existing.
- Changes to hardscape and landscaping will be visually compatible with the architecture and the existing landscaping that is to remain.
